Orange County, NY benefits from a diverse labor shed that extends beyond its borders into neighboring counties and even parts of northern NJ and northeastern PA.

With a regional workforce of over 560,000 and a local civilian labor force of approximately 184,000, the county draws talent from a broad geographic area thanks to its strategic location and strong transportation infrastructure, including I-84, I-87, and Metro-North rail access.

The workforce is well-rounded, with strengths in healthcare, logistics, manufacturing, construction, and professional services.



Orange boasts 3 interstate highways and numerous recently upgraded interchanges to accomodate your ground transportation needs.



In Orange County, your business will have an International Airport and multiple regional airports, right in your backyard.

#### **AVERAGE COMMUTE TIME:**



- 40% of commuters travel less than 20 minutes.
- Nearly 20% commute over 60 minutes.
- About 9.3% are classified as "super-commuters," traveling more than 90 minutes each way.

This extended commute time reflects Orange County's position as a commuter hub with strong connections to the greater Hudson Valley, Northern New Jersey, and New York City via I-84, I-87, and the Metro-North Port Jervis Line.


